Resolution 2016-21 Mount Holly Fire District No.1

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY, DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, NATURAL & HISTORIC RESOURCES, HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICE

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No. 1 in the Township of Mount Holly, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey (the "Fire District"), received approval for the construction of an addition and renovations to the Relief Fire Engine Company No.1 firehouse located at 17 Pine Street, Mount Holly, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the site and building referenced above is a contributing building to the Mount Holly Historic District as listed on the New Jersey Register of Historic Places as of August 7, 1972, and the National Register of Historic Places on February 20, 1973; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Register of Historic Places Act, Chapter 268, Laws of 1970, requires prior written authorization from the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Protection for any undertaking of a public entity, or agency thereof, which may affect those properties listed as set forth above; and

WHEREAS, to initiate review of the project for authorization, an application must be submitted to the Historic Preservation Office,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No. 1, Township of Mount Holly, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that application for project authorization for the 17 Pine Street, Mount Holly, New Jersey, proposed addition and renovations be submitted to the Historic Preservation Office; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Director of Fire Services, Board Chairman and Board Solicitor be authorized to prepare and execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the above and the Board Clerk attest thereto; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the within Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any resolution or part of a resolution inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed or otherwise revoked; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Resolution is for any reason held or determined to be unconstitutional or invalid, same shall not affect the remainder of this Resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notwithstanding anything set forth herein to the contrary, the Board shall be permitted to amend, modify, repeal or otherwise act as to those topics which are the subject of this Resolution provided said acts are consistent with public

policy, Board bylaws, township ordinances, local, state and federal laws and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that an original signed, conformed and compared copy of this Resolution be accessible and maintained as an official Board record pursuant to and in accordance with the "Open Public Records Act"; N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1 *et seq.* and the "Destruction of Public Records Law (1953)" N.J.S.A. 47:3-8.1, *et seq.* as set forth by the State of New Jersey Municipal Agency Record Retention Schedule promulgated by the Division of Archives and Records Management.
