**MOUNT HOLLY FIRE DISTRICT No.1**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF CLAIMS**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No. 1, Township of Mount Holly, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey is charged with fire suppression, protection and prevention within the District; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to fulfill its mandated charge as set forth above, it is necessary that the Board procure services and goods; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has purchasing procedures and guidelines in place which comply with the Local Public Contract Laws for the procurement of such services and goods; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has in its employ a Director of Fire Services who is also a Qualified Purchasing Agent; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board finds and determines that in order to maintain and facilitate continuity while providing fire service that it is necessary to authorize payment of claims at times when the Board is not constituted.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOVLED**, by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No. 1, Township of Mount Holly, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that it authorize the Director of Fire Services, Ryan E. Donnelly, as a certified Qualified Purchasing Agent for the Board, to direct the payment of claims for contracted service, requisitioned items and other procurement as he is authorized to do as a Qualified Purchasing Agent at times when he deems necessary for continuity of operations; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that at the next duly convened Board meeting the Director of Fire Services shall present a list of those expenditures and payments to the Board for reaffirmation of payment; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that all such authorizations for payment be performed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the within Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that any resolution or part of a resolution inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or otherwise revoked; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase in this Resolution is for any reason held or determined to be unconstitutional or invalid same shall not affect the remainder of this Resolution; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that notwithstanding anything set forth herein to the contrary the Board shall be permitted to amend, modify, repeal or otherwise act as to those topics which are the subject of this Resolution provided said acts are consistent with public policy, Board bylaws, township ordinances, local, state and federal laws and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder; and


