The proposed 2022 budget increases the amount to be raised by taxation in order to complete the District's current fire station rehabilitation and addition project which was undertaken in 2021. Soft costs associated with professional services coupled with an increase in personnel costs to be incurred during the restructuring of the Bureau of Fire Prevention account for majority of increases in the proposed 2022 budget. The proposed 2022 budget focuses on improvements to vital infrastructure and personnel deployment.

If Unrestricted Fund Balance is reduced by more than 10%, explain the projected impact on the following year's budget.

The proposed 2022 budget will show an increase in the tax rate from 0.179 in 2021 to 0.186 in 2022. An owner of a home assessed at the Township average of \$171,068 will see an increase in their annual Fire District tax of approximately \$15.21. The District will again utilize unrestricted fund balance to offset increases in the annual operating budget for 2022 as we continue to cover soft costs associated with the fire station rehabilitation within the annual budget. This anticipates that any unforeseen costs associated with the project will be covered with bond proceeds. Should the project be completed as per the contract issued without significant unforeseen costs, the balance of funds available through bond proceeds will reimburse the general fund. Following this year of construction, the District will begin to replenish its unrestricted fund balance.

Future capital expenditures, such as apparatus replacement, will be funded through the use of the capital fund.
